Flyball Run for Rescue Tournament

August 2-3, 2008

**Wayne County Fairgrounds
Belleville, Michigan**

Thank you for entering our *2nd Annual “Flyball Run for Rescue”* tournament being held at the Wayne County Fairgrounds in Belleville, Michigan. Fairgrounds open Friday at 8 AM and the tournament building will be open at 3PM. Head Judge is Jason Crawford. Jennifer Durocher is the relief judge.

DIRECTIONS: The fairgrounds are located at 10871 Quirk Road in Belleville, right off the I-94 Service Drive, west of the Belleville Road I-94 Exit. Phone number to the fairgrounds is 734-697-7002.

CRATING: Outdoor crating only.

**Please enter and exit through the north end of the Merchants Building where racing is held.
Pools will be located on the east side of the building.**

MEASURING: Measuring will take place between 7:30 am and 7:45 am on Saturday. There will not be a captains meeting.

WARM-UPS: There will be a two minute warm-up but may be shortened if racing runs behind schedule. If your team is ready to race before the warm up ends, please let your judge know.

RACING:

Racing will begin at 8:00 am on both Saturday and Sunday.

Racing has been divided into 4 Regular and 2 Multi-Breed divisions according to the submitted team times. Each division has been assigned a break-out time one second faster than the top seed time in that division (for additional information see NAFA rule 5.5)

RACING FORMAT:

All racing 3/5

Regular divisions 1, 2 and Mix 1: TRR, one point for a win, zero for a loss.

Regular divisions 3, 4 and Mix 2: DRR, one point for a win, zero for a loss.

Ties will be broken based on head to head racing, then best time head to head, and then best time overall.

LUNCH: Currently, a lunch break is not anticipated. If this changes, signs will be posted.

AWARDS: For teams that place in their division, we will be giving a donation to the rescue of their choice that is a legal nonprofit either 501c3 or State nonprofit corporation. 1st Place will be \$100 donation; 2nd Place will be \$75 donation; 3rd Place will be a \$50 donation. If a team prefers not to designate a rescue, the placement donation will go to a local rescue. We hope you will be able to join in the recognition of tournament placings and our special awards **AT THE CONCLUSION OF RACING** Sunday.

SATURDAY HOT DOG STAND. On Saturday, we will have a hot dog stand to raise additional funds for local rescues.

RAFFLE: Plan to participate in our great raffle. Prices will be posted. Tickets will be sold 8 am - 5 pm Saturday and 8 am - 1:45 pm Sunday. Please make sure to purchase your tickets and place them in the containers prior to 2:00 pm Sunday. Drawing will be 2:00 to 2:30 pm Sunday and results will be posted at the conclusion of the drawing. The **Ann Arbor Pet Supplies Plus** is sponsoring our special **36" Canine Camper** soft side crate raffle.

BOX & LINE JUDGING VOLUNTEERS: For each race one of you volunteers to box or line judge, we are offering a free raffle ticket. Judge 10 races, get 10 raffle tickets. Please see the JYD Team Members supervising box judging for your free raffle tickets after judging (we try to leave the line judges alone for this task).

CAMPING: The fairgrounds has tent, 20 amp and 30 amp hookups. Reservations are be made directly with the fairgrounds and needs to be done ASAP by calling 734.697.7002. The fairgrounds has electricity, water, restrooms, showers and free dumping with camping.
