Thank you for entering our **4<sup>th</sup> Annual "Flyball Run for Rescue"** tournament being held at the Wayne County Fairgrounds in Belleville, Michigan. Fairgrounds open Friday at 8 a.m. and the tournament building will be open at 4 p.m. for setup...hint, hint.

We once again welcome Brian Kauk as our Head Judge and Annette Tindall as our Relief Judge.

**AWARDS:** For teams that place in their division, we will be giving a donation to the rescue of their choice that is a legal nonprofit either 501c3 or State nonprofit corporation -- 1st Place will be \$100 donation; 2nd Place will be \$75 donation; 3rd Place will be a \$50 donation. If a team doesn't designate a rescue, the placement donation will go to a local rescue. We hope you will be able to join in the recognition of tournament placements and our special awards **IMMEDIATELY AFTER RACING** on Sunday.

**LINE AND BOX JUDGING:** We may be a little short-handed since we are also running on teams; therefore, anyone who line or box judges will receive a ticket per race they judge. See Deb to get your tickets for judging.

**MILLER'S BAR AND THE YPSILANTI HERITAGE FESTIVAL.** For entertainment on Saturday evening, we suggest you take a trip to Miller's Bar (our sponsor – [www.MillersBar.com](http://www.MillersBar.com)) a couple miles east in Dearborn and experience the best burger in Detroit. **RAFFLE:** Plan to participate in our great raffle. Ticket prices and drawing time on Sunday will be posted. Once again, Pet Supplies Plus has donated some wonderful prizes along with your team entry bags.

This Junkyard Dogs' tournament will mark over \$8,000 in donations given to dog rescues on behalf of our flyball community. Thank you for participating in this great effort which means so much to this all-rescue flyball club.

**DIRECTIONS:** The fairgrounds are located at 10871 Quirk Road in Belleville, right off the I-94 Service Drive, west of the Belleville Road I-94 Exit. Phone number to the fairgrounds is 734-697-7002.

**CRATING:** Outdoor crating only.

***Please enter and exit through the north end of the Merchants Building where racing is held. Pools will be located on the east side of the building and EZ-ups will be setup for rain or shine waiting or wading.***

**MEASURING:** Measuring will take place at 7:45 a.m. on Saturday. There will not be a captains meeting.

**RACING:** Racing will begin at 8:00 am on both Saturday and Sunday with Singles and Pairs racing at the beginning and end of the days.

Racing has been divided into four Standard and one Variety divisions according to the submitted team times. Each division has been assigned a break-out time one second faster than the top seed time in that division.

**RACING FORMAT:** All racing 3/5

Standard divisions 1 and 2: DRR with DE, one point for a win, zero for a loss.

Standard divisions 2 and 3: DRR, one point for a win, zero for a loss.

Variety division 1: SRR with DE, one point for a win, zero for a loss.

Ties will be broken based on head to head racing, then best time head to head, and then best time overall.

**WARM-UPS:** There will be a two minute warm-up but may be shortened if racing runs behind schedule. If your team is ready to race before the warm up ends, please let your judge know.

**LUNCH:** No lunch break is currently scheduled. If this changes, signs will be posted.

**CAMPING:** The fairgrounds has tent, 20 amp and 30 amp (30 amp is further away from the tourney site) hookups. Reservations are made directly with the fairgrounds and needs to be done ASAP by calling 734.697.7002. The fairgrounds has electricity, water, restrooms, showers and free dumping with camping.
